The National Partnership Council (NPC) is comprised of management officials in all three Administrations and select staff offices and union representatives from AFGE, NAGE, NFFE, NNOC-NNU, and SEIU. Two of the overarching objectives of the NPC are to provide recommendations on program initiatives that impact employees and to promote cooperative labor-management relations, including partnership, within the VA community.

The Strategic Analytics for Improvement and Learning (SAIL) Value Model is a web-based balanced scorecard model developed by VA to measure, evaluate and benchmark quality and efficiency at VA medical centers. SAIL is used for internal benchmarking within VHA to spotlight the successful strategies of VA's top performers and to promote high quality, safety and value-based health care across all its VAMCs.

The NPC endorses the use of SAIL metrics to support improvement and learning, consistent with VHA's vision of "learning, discovery and continuous improvement."
