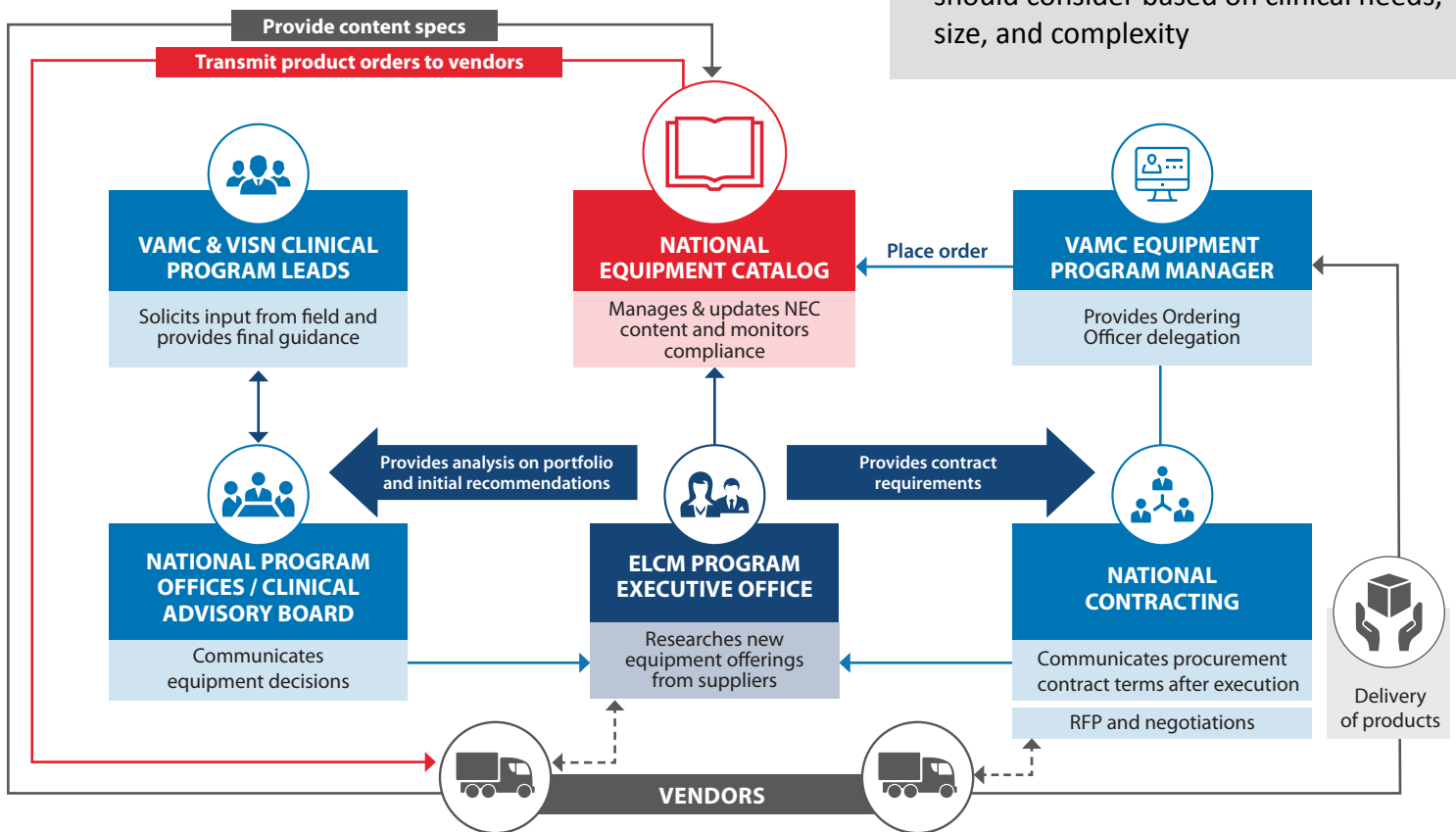


## SUMMARY
