

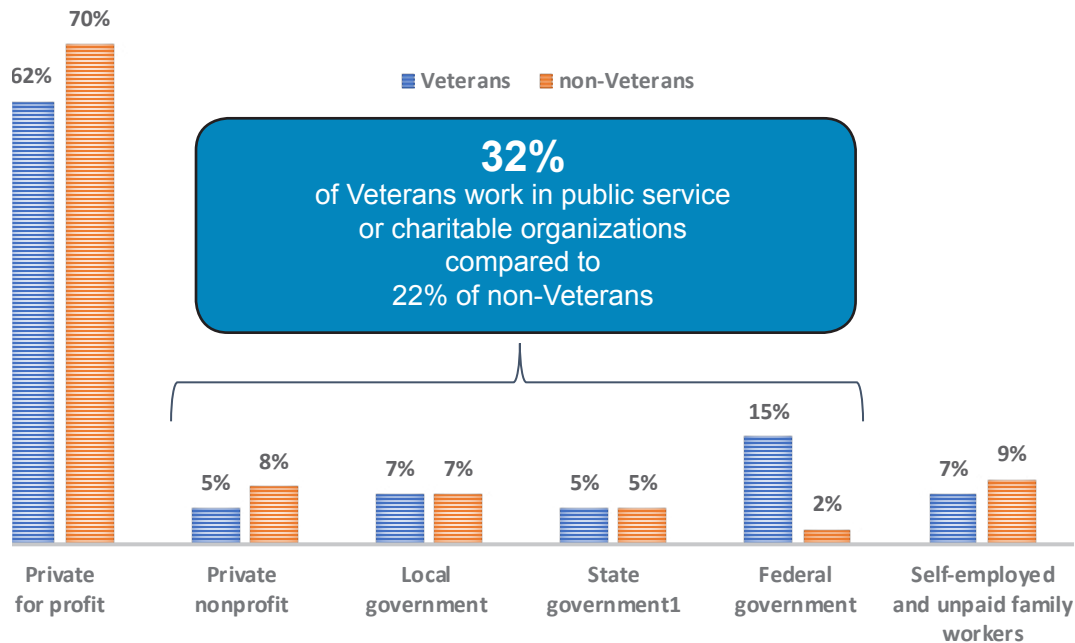

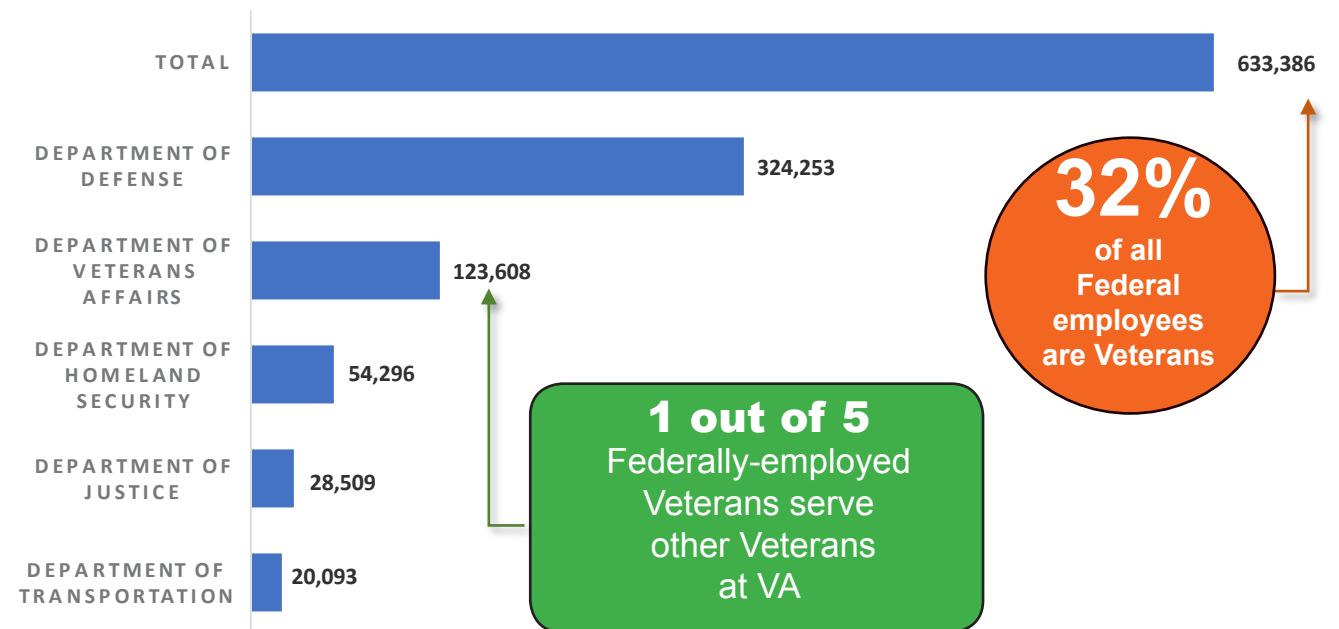
National Center for Veterans Analysis and Statistics celebrates Veterans Day 2019 by highlighting ways Veterans continue their service to the nation even after the uniform comes off
